Kingdom Come

Mat 7:7-11; The King's Kindness

Sunday Oct 26	Reading: Matthew 7:7-11 Prayer: Give thanks to our heavenly Father who bids us to ask and seek and knock with the promise that the door will always be open to us in Jesus.
Monday Oct 27	Reading: Deuteronomy 16-17 Prayer: Pray for Ian and Heidi Fry and their kids as they work with Eden Ministries in Zimbabwe . Pray for the Frys and for the staff and children at Eden Village and for practical provisions like good weather, rain, and an abundant harvest. Praise God that after 27 years, Eden has finally been recognized as a Private Voluntary Organization, giving them increased simplicity and flexibility to their operations.
