Knowing the King
Mat 7:21-23

Sunday Nov 16	Reading: Matthew 7:15-20 Prayer: Praise the Lord who has loved us and drawn near to us to know us, and so that we can know Him.
Monday Nov 17	Reading: Deuteronomy 28-29 Prayer: Pray for Austin Slater and his wife Jessi as Austin leads an RUF International ministry at the University of Central Florida . Pray that the Lord would use their relationships with international students to plant seeds and to draw many to true faith. Pray for fruitful engagement with students through this semester’s “dinner and discussions” using narratives from Luke. Pray that many students would further connect with their ministry and would encounter and respond to the Gospel in faith.
