Sunday August 9	Scripture: Isaiah 59-63 Prayer: Listen to your heart. What do you feel you want more of today? Is it Jesus or is it something else you think will make you happy? Ask the Spirit to search your heart.
Monday August 10	Scripture: Isaiah 64-66 Prayer: Look around you. "All things are yours" (1Cor 13:21-23). Everything is yours in Christ, but everything is worthless without Christ. Meditate on His worth today.
Tuesday August 11	Scripture: Jeremiah 1-3 Prayer: Pray for more contentment. Declare your discontentment with your low level of contentment. Ask God to show you more of His gifts and to quiet your soul with His peace.
Wednesday August 12	Scripture: Jeremiah 4-6 Prayer: Pray for all of our students as they prepare for another year of study.
