Sunday May 3	Scripture: 1 Chronicles 9-11 Prayer: Meditate on the present reality of Jesus seated on His throne, ruling all things for His glory <i>and for your good.</i>
Monday May 4	Scripture: 1 Chronicles 12-14 Prayer: What do you exalt higher than Jesus? Repent and exalt Jesus for His work to forgive your sins.
Tuesday May 5	Scripture: 1 Chronicles 15-17 Prayer: Pray specifically for people in your life who do not highly exalt Jesus. Pray for grace to exalt Jesus as His witness by sharing how He humbled Himself on a cross to forgive our sins.
