 2 Pet 3:1-10

Sunday Mar 15	Reading: I Corinthians 5-6 Prayer: Praise the Lord who is patient with us and kind to us, so that we might receive His Son and repent of our sins.
Monday Mar 16	Reading: Genesis 40-43 Prayer: Pray for MTW missionaries Tom and Karen Mirabella as they work to plant churches in Chiba, Japan. Pray for God to work mightily in Japan where fewer than 1% of the population is Evangelical Christian. Praise God for the arrival of the Mirabellas' first grandchild and for a wonderful visit with their entire family. Pray for their final month of travel to churches before returning to Japan at the end of March. Pray for their teammates, Yuji and Eri, as they are working towards a new church plant in Chiba, and pray for wisdom for Tom and Karen's future plans for ministry.
Tuesday Mar 17	Reading: I Samuel 1-5 Prayer: Repent of doubting His return or questioning His sincerity. Trust that His "delay" is so that others might repent before it is too late.

Thursday Mar 19	Reading: Job 21-22 Prayer: Pray for grace to make the loving sacrifices that could lead our neighbors and the nations to repent and believe in Jesus.
Friday Mar 20	Reading: Isaiah 56-61 Prayer: Pray for High Bridge Presbyterian Church, a mission church in Farmville , as they continue to grow and reach their community.
Saturday Mar 21	Reading: Mark 1-2 Prayer: Pray that kids at Tab would clearly hear the call of the gospel, that they would respond in faith, and that they would grow to become life-long followers of Jesus!
