## When the World Doesn't Make Sense

Ecc 1:1-11; *Nothing New Under the Sun*

<b>Sunday</b> June 7	<b>Reading: Galatians 4-6</b> <b>Prayer:</b> Praise the Lord who doesn't leave us to guess about what will full our hearts and our lives, but who shows us the vanity and emptiness of filling them with anything besides Him.
<b>Monday</b> June 8	<b>Reading: Exodus 37-40</b> <b>Prayer:</b> Pray for UVA's RUF campus minister, <b>Josiah Carey</b> and his wife Kelley and four children. Pray that they would faithfully proclaim Christ crucified and risen, and that His Spirit would be at work in <b>RUF at the University of Virginia</b> .
