Sunday July 5	Reading: Philippians 3-4 Prayer: Give thanks to the Giver of all gifts, and enjoy all the good things He has put into your hands to do. “So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God” (1Cor 10:31).
Monday July 6	Reading: Leviticus 10-12 Prayer: Pray for Willis Weatherford , the campus minister with RUF at Washington & Lee University .
