Sunday July 12	Reading: Colossians 1-2 Prayer: Give thanks for the seasons God leads us into to know Him better, not only as the Giver of good gifts, but also the one who strengthens us for any difficulty.
Monday July 13	Reading: Leviticus 13-15 Prayer: Pray for Don Ward as he works with Equipping Leaders International (ELI) in Malawi training pastors and national leaders who, in turn, pour their lives into local ministry. Pray also for his ELI Malawi teammates Bentry Mhango and Greg Rittenhouse. Pray for Don and his wife Caron as they travel to Malawi from July 10–22. Pray for effective ministry as Don and his team teach on Romans 9-16 and as Caron and others minister to the children at Kamwankhuku Presbyterian Church.
