May the Word of God SHAPE and MOLD us into the image of Jesus!

CHECK INS: Let's check in quick with each other; how are we doing folks...?!?

10.12.25 - SERMON RECAP:

This week we looked into the passage of John 21:1-14, where Jesus reveals himself yet again to the Disciples who had gone out fishing on the Sea of Galilee. Jesus reveals himself right here at an ordinary place and His works of a miraculous fish catch again catches the disciples attention that this was Jesus! Then when they get to shore Jesus invites them to sit and have breakfast. There a few truths and points of encouragement we can glean from this passage for our walk as disciples of Jesus today! Turn in our bibles to John 21:1-14. (As a group, lets take turns reading this scripture together; and then ponder/discuss these questions for our lives.)

DIGGING DEEPER:

1. At HVC we are beginning the final chapter (ch 21 of the Gospel of John) and are starting to land the plane on our series in this great book... We were challenged to re-read this gospel in its entirety to reconsider it's themes and application in our lives. Have we been re-reading a chapter a day so far?? How might we as a HC commit to reading back through this book in the coming weeks?? May we challenge and hold each other accountable to indeed re-read this book!
2. Back to our passage... The disciples make a decision to go fishing. In your mind, why would the disciples go do a day of fishing in the midst of all of whats been going on?? If you were one of the disciples in this time after seeing Jesus die and rise, what would you be doing??
3. What are 3 regular/ordinary places you find yourself throughout a given week? How can you open yourself up intentionally to meet with Jesus in these places throughout the day??
4. What are some areas of our life we desire Christ to be revealed to us, in this season??
5. As you are filled in Jesus... How can you help reveal Jesus in these same places??
6. In our passage, John connects Jesus' present work to those of the past... Can you describe an instance where you connected Jesus' working in your life from his previous works?
7. Are there times you've missed the connection? Why do you suppose that is? In this same thought, would beckoning him to reveal himself to you daily make the connection more clear?
8. Share some Testimonies: How have you seen the Spirit move in your life (either recently or sometime in the past)? And then, How has God revealed Himself to you in a powerful way??
9. Take time to share these specific things with our community and lets pray for each other in these areas.
