11.23.25 - SERMON RECAP:

This week we continued in our series teaching through HVC's Core Values. This past Sunday we looked at the Values of Kingdom Multiplication- and how we are called to **Recieve the Gospel, Grow in its fruit, and Sow it into others' Lives**. God is always at work in the our lives cultivating the soil of our heart, so that we as believers can grow to live out the truth of scripture and Sow that truth broadly. Lets consider today how Kingdom Multiplication is a work of God in peoples lives. Lets turn to Matthew 13:1-9; 18-23 and read this scripture together. (As a group, lets take turns reading this scripture together; and then ponder/discuss these questions for our lives.)

DIGGING DEEPER:

1. As we approach Thanksgiving, what are you most thankful for in your life, and in our church? How do those things reflect the core values we've discussed (Gospel Transformation, Compassionate Engagement, Authentic Relationship, Kingdom Multiplication)?
2. In your own words, what does "Kingdom Multiplication" mean? How does the life cycle of a plant help you understand the Life Cycle of Kingdom Multiplication?
3. Which of the four soil types (Path, Rocky, Thorny, Good) do you most relate to in your spiritual journey now, and your heart condition toward God's Word? Why?
4. What does it look like in practical terms to "receive the word" in your daily life? How do you know if the seed is taking root?
5. What spiritual practices help you cultivate a receptive, fruitful heart that multiplies 30, 60, or 100-fold (Matt. 13:23)? See: John 15:1-8; 1 Timothy 4:7-8.
6. Romans 10:14-15, 17 emphasizes the importance of preaching and hearing the Word. What are some ways you can actively sow Gospel seeds in your current circles of influence?
7. Do you tend to sow broadly (sharing widely) or invest deeply (discipling personally)? How can both operate in healthy balance in your life and our body at HVC?
8. Are there any "rocks" or "thorns" you sense God is working to remove? How can we be praying and walking along side each other as God works on each of us?
9. Where is God inviting you to invest spiritually in one or two people who could multiply into others?

As we wrap up take time to share someone who you could as a group be praying for to come to know Christ, and pray for opportunities to Sow the gospel in that person's life.
