1.25.26 - SERMON RECAP:

As we continue in our Series on Disciples of Jesus we are reminded that we get to Celebrate our Salvation in Christ. There are various Roles in God's redemptive story from the prophets searching and foretelling to Christ fulfilling Peter is reminding the Church that we are the recipients of the long awaited Salvation and are brought into the story as proclaimers of the Gospel and Disciples of Christ. Lets be encouraged today in Gratitude and Celebration of God's grace and mercy and recognize the great privilege of living in the revealing of God's redemption. Lets turn to I Peter 1:6-9 and read this together.

DIGGING DEEPER:

1. What are the realities of our salvation, and how does knowing these truths strengthen our lives? What about our Salvation are we Celebrating today ?
2. Verse 12 asserts that the prophets were not serving their own interests, but rather serving the interests of you and me. Does this truth influence your perception of the Old Testament prophets? If so, how?
3. Peter says the prophets "searched and inquired carefully." What does this teach us about their hunger to understand God's plan, and how might it challenge our own approach to Scripture?
4. The prophets were ultimately serving us a future generation. Can you think of people in your life who invested in you spiritually without seeing the full results? How might God be calling you to invest in others the same way?
5. The apostles preached the gospel through the enabling of the Holy Spirit. How does the Holy Spirit guide the spread of the gospel in our modern world? How does the Holy Spirit influence your ministry and impact the lives of those you serve?
6. The end of Vs 12 the angels "long to look" into the mystery of salvation. What does their curiosity and wonder say about the value and beauty of the gospel we sometimes take for granted?
7. As we recall and celebrate God's love for us from the very beginning of time, how can we incorporate celebrating this truth into our daily lives? What factors distract us or lead us to take advantage of this truth?
8. Read Matthew 28:18-20: What are one or two practical steps you can take this week to live out this calling in your home, workplace, school, or community?
