7.26.26 - SERMON RECAP:

This week we begin a new series Family on Mission—looking at several key priorities/distinctives of God's Mission looking at the early church in the book of Acts. As an introductory overview we looked at these 7-Distinctives of God's Mission which must drive our own mission- as a Family on Mission. As we unpack this series, may we be: A Spirit-Empowered Witness, A Global-Focused People, A Local-Serving Presence, A Harvest-Focused Laborer, A Gospel-Sharing Fruitful-Influence, A Boldly-Generous Family, and A Disciple-Multiplying Community. Read Acts 1:8-11; 2:1-4; and 2:41-47 together and consider some discussion questions to allow this passage to transform us!

DIGGING DEEPER:

1. A Spirit-Empowered Witness. Read: Acts 1:8; John 15:26–27. in your own thoughts, why is it impossible to faithfully live God's mission apart from the power and work of the Holy Spirit?
2. A Global-Focused People. Read: Acts 1:8; Matthew 28:18–20; Revelation 7:9–10. How does God's heart for all nations challenge the way we think about our own lives and priorities?
3. A Local-Serving Presence. Read: Acts 2:42–47; Galatians 6:9–10. Why is serving the needs among the Grand Valley and our neighbors others such a powerful demonstration of the gospel?
4. A Harvest-Focused Laborer. Read: Matthew 9:35–38; Acts 2:37–41. What keeps many believers from seeing themselves as workers in God's harvest instead of simply consumers of the church?
5. A Gospel-Sharing, Fruitful Influence. Read: Acts 2:46–47; Romans 1:16. What makes sharing our faith intimidating, and what gives us confidence to speak about Jesus anyway?
6. A Boldly-Generous Family. Read: Acts 2:44–45; II Corinthians 9:6–8. How does generosity reflect the character of God and strengthen the witness of the Church?
7. Beyond finances, what resources—your time, abilities, home, encouragement, or relationships—has God entrusted to you to bless others?
8. A Disciple-Multiplying Community. Read: Acts 2:42; II Timothy 2:2. Why must discipleship be more than simply attending church or gaining biblical knowledge? Who is helping you grow as a disciple of Jesus? Who are you intentionally investing in and helping follow Christ?
9. Living the Mission Together. Read: Acts 1:8; Acts 2:42–47; Ephesians 4:11–16
10. These seven priorities describe the God's mission of the early church—not merely individual Christians. Which of these priorities is strongest in your life? Which one needs the greatest growth? How do all seven work together to create a healthy, mission-focused church?
