1. God is the only One worthy to judge the world. 15:1-8
He is great, amazing, just, true, mighty, holy, righteous, and eternal.

2. God is the only One with authority to judge the world. 16:1-21
He called for the judgements. v1
He brought the judgements. v5
He claims the judgements as His own. v6
He completes His judgments. v17

And Jesus cried out and said, "Whoever believes in me, believes not in me but in him who sent me.

And whoever sees me sees him who sent me.
