2. testify for Jesus in our salvation. 19:6-10, Hosea 2:19, 1 Peter 2:21
3. prepare for the return of Christ. 19:11-21, Matthew 25:1-13, 2 Peter 3:10
4. look forward to His reign. 20:1-10, Isaiah 2:4; 42:1, Romans 8:18-23
5. fear God's judgement over His enemies. 20:11-15, Romans 2:6, Matthew 25:31-36

John 12:46-48

I have come into the world as light, so that whoever believes in me may not remain in darkness.
If anyone hears my words and does not keep them, I do not judge him;
for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world.
The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge;
