Major commercial center known for trade, culture, and spiritual diversity




The Challenge

Believers faced immense pressure from the surrounding pagan culture

Historical Context of Ephesus

- Temple of Artemis One of the Seven Wonders of the World
- A significant Jewish population
- Roman province center with emperor worship

Christ In Us


- His ongoing presence transforms us


