#### Barna Research - Knowledge and Practice Gaps

#### (S) Barna, 2023: "The Resilient Disciple" study

- Only 21% of U.S. Christians are considered "resilient disciples"—those whose beliefs and behaviors align with historic Christian faith and regularly engage in Scripture, church, and mission.
- Among those who identify as Christian:
  - · 58% don't actively practice their faith.
  - 40% say they believe Christian teachings, but do not let them shape daily decisions.

Insight: A majority identify as Christian culturally, but few consistently live out the implications of the gospel.

#### The Purpose


God strengthens us not merely for our comfort, but to empower our testimony and transform our character to reflect Christ.


