3. How does Jesus fulfilling the Law and opening access to God change the way I approach Him this week? Do I come to God with confidence, honesty, and gratitude—or with distance, fear, or self-effort?
4. If Jesus were to reveal what's truly in my heart, what would He find—and what needs to change? Simeon said Jesus would reveal the thoughts of many hearts. What response is Jesus inviting from me today: repentance, trust, surrender, or renewed faith?

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
