2. Are you fighting sin as a debt you owe or as a son who has already received freedom through Christ?

3. When you face fear, do you respond with faith in your adoption, or do you fall back into old patterns of spiritual anxiety?
(Rom. 8:15; 2 Tim. 1:7)
4. Are you being led by the Spirit through Scripture, or are your decisions mostly driven by feelings and circumstances?
(Gal. 5:16; Psa. 119:133)
5. What evidence of Spirit-produced growth—such as love, self-control, or steadfastness—is increasing in your life right now?
(2 Pet. 1:5–8; Gal. 5:22–23)
6. Do you approach God with boldness and intimacy as your Father, or do you keep Him at a distance out of fear or guilt?

7. Is your obedience to God motivated by fear of punishment or by trust in His love and acceptance?
(1 Jn. 4:18; Rom. 8:1)
8. When doubts arise about your standing with God, do you look to your relationship with Christ and the Spirit's leading for assurance, or do you focus on your failures?
(Rom. 8:16; Eph. 1:13–14)

"Paul is not referring here to spectacular instances of divine guidance in the lives of eminent Christians. Rather, he is speaking of what is true of all sons of God—namely, that they are led by the Spirit of God. It is not a question of the degree in which they are yielded to the Holy Spirit, but of a relationship which takes place at the time of conversion."
