**Genesis 4** <sup>2</sup>And again, she bore his brother Abel. 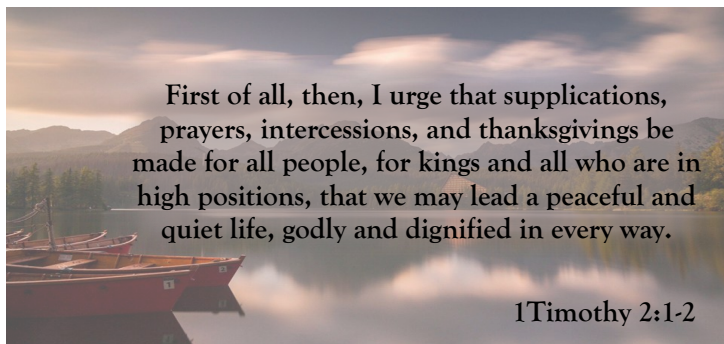

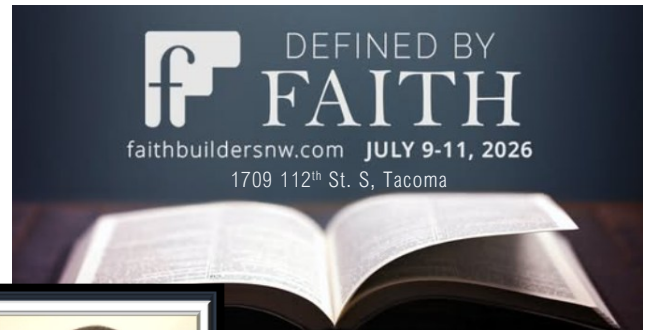
