



# "The Story of the Old Testament"

Wednesday nights, 6-9 pm Jan 29-April 30.

Teacher: Dr. Mark McLean

This course is a three-credit hour survey of the Old Testament. Mature high school juniors and seniors may take the class for credit. Credit students will be expected to spend 4-6 hours a week outside of class on homework assignments, as is typical for college work. Students are expected to purchase the textbook and bring a good *print* copy of the Bible in a standard translation.

Cost & Registration - For students who would like to audit the class, the recommended donation is \$30. For those taking the course for *college credit*, the course fee is \$60. Registration is required so we can set up chairs appropriately.
