Psalms 19

I. The Glory of God's C_____:

- a. **heavens** & **expanse** focus our attention on God's Power as the Creator (cf. Gen. 1:1-8)
- b. God's creation leaves all men without an excuse (cf. Rom. 1:20)
- c. God's creation is constantly revealing Him without words
- d. **line** = voice (cf. Isa. 28:10)
- e. the **sun** and its course in the sky is constant testimony of God's glory

II. The Glory of God's W_____:

- a. David gives 6 names, along with 6 truths and 6 effects or consequences of God's Word
 - i. **⁷ The law of the Lord is perfect, restoring the soul;** (cf. Ps 1:2; 12:6; 18:30; Prov. 30:5; Rom. 7:12)
 - 1. **el = God**
 - 2. **Lord = Yahweh = "I AM WHO I AM"** (cf. Ex. 3:14)
 - ii. **⁷ ...The testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.** (cf. Ex. 25:16, 21, 22, 26; Num. 9:15; 17:4; 17:10; cf. Ps. 119:2, 14, 22, 24, 88)
 - iii. **⁸ The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart;**

- iv. **⁸ ...The commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes.** (cf. Ps. 119:105)

- v. **⁹ The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever;** (cf. Prov. 9:10)

- vi. **The judgments of the Lord are true; they are righteous altogether. ¹⁰ They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb. ¹¹ Moreover, by them Your servant is warned; In keeping them there is great reward.** (cf. Heb. 9:27; Ps. 119:7, 13, 43, 52, 62, 138)

III. The Glory of God's G_____:

- a. David lists several of the terms we use for sin (Ps. 51:1-2; cf. Ex. 21:14; Lev. 4; Num. 15; Deut. 17:12; Ps. 32:1-2; 18:2, 31, 46; 51; 104:34)
 - i. Sin = overarching
 - ii. Trespass = perhaps unintentional
 - iii. Transgress = intentional
 - iv. Iniquity = without repentance
- b. The human heart is deceitful and only God can know it (cf. Jer. 17:9-11)
- c. Our hope is not in religion or ritual, but instead in our **Lord, rock, and Redeemer**
