

The King's Coronation—Part 1
"Seven Significant Aspects"
Selected Scriptures

I. The P_____ (Dan. 9:24-26)

- a. **weeks = 7 years**
- b. **seventy weeks = 490 years**
- c. **seven weeks and sixty-two weeks = 483 years**
- d. **Artaxerxes' decree = March 14th 445 B.C.**
- e. **Add 483 years = April 6th 32 A.D.; the 10th day of Nisan**
- f. Jesus is **Messiah the Prince**

II. The P_____ (John 12:1-8)

- a. Anointing = "to consecrate or make sacred in a ceremony that includes the token applying of oil" (cf. 1 Sam. 16:3; Exodus 28:41; 29:7; 30:30; Leviticus 8:30; 10:7; 1 Kings. 19:16)
- b. **Six days before the Passover** = Saturday, the Sabbath
 - i. Matthew & Mark record this anointing as a Flashback to explain Judas' betrayal (cf. Matt. 26:6-13; Mark 14:3-9)
 - ii. NOT the anointing from Luke 7:36-50
- c. Mary chose what was best! (cf. Luke 10:40-42)

III. The P_____ (John 12:4-6; Matt. 26:3-6)

- a. **Three hundred denarii** = a full year's wages
 - i. **thirty pieces of silver** = 120 denarii
 - ii. What is your soul worth? (cf. Mark 8:37-38)

IV. The P_____ (Mark 11:1-7)

- a. Some Jewish kings rode donkeys to their coronation (1 Kings 1:33; cf. Judges 5:10; 10:4; 12:14; 2 Sam. 16:2)
- b. Zechariah prophesized the Messiah would ride in on a donkey (cf. Zech. 9:9)

V. The P_____ (Matt. 21:8-9)

- a. Jews had laid **their coats in the road** for previous kings (cf. 2 Kings 9:13)
- b. **Son of David** = most widely used title for the Messiah (cf. Matt. 9:27; 12:23; 15:22; 20:30-31; 21:9; Matt. 21:14-16; 22:42; Mark 10:47-48; 11:10; 12:35; Luke 1:32; 18:38-39; 20:41-44; John 7:42; Acts 2:25-34; Acts 13:34-36; Rom. 1:3; 2 Tim. 2:8; Rev. 5:5; 22:16)
- c. **BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD** (cf. Ps. 118:26; Jer. 33:15-16; Isa. 4:2; 11:1-5; Zech. 3:8; 6:12-13)

VI. The P_____ (Luke 19:39-40; Mark 11:10-11)

- a. The Pharisees knew the crowds were worshiping Jesus
- b. Creation itself would **cry out** if necessary, because of the joy from the end of its groaning (cf. Rom. 8:19-22)
- c. The people of Judah didn't recognize Him
- d. The people of Galilee misunderstood Him

VII. The P_____ (Luke 23:39-43)

- a. The second thief had a Holy Spirit empowered transformation of heart (cf. John 3:1-8)
 - i. He confessed his sin
 - ii. He confirmed that Jesus was the Christ, divinely holy
 - iii. He asked for Jesus' forgiveness
- b. **Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in Paradise**
