

Who Killed Jesus?
Matthew 20:17-19

I. The S_____ (v. 17)

- a. Jesus is journeying through Perea with the Passover Pilgrims
- b. He is going **up to Jerusalem** because Jericho is roughly 700ft below sea level and Jerusalem is roughly 2500ft above sea level
- c. "**Jesus was walking on ahead of them; and they were amazed, and those who followed were fearful.**" (Mark 10:32)
- d. **aside by themselves = kat' iδian** (κατ' ιδιαν) = "privately"

II. The S_____ (vs. 18-19)

- a. **Behold** (cf. Matt. 12:40; 16:21; 17:22-23)
- b. **we are going up to Jerusalem** = the disciples share the risk
- c. **the Son of Man** (cf. Dan. 7:13-14; Matt. 9:6; 11:19; 12:32; 13:37; 17:12; 26:64; Mark 2:28; 9:9; Luke 9:56, 58; 12:8; 19:10; John 1:51; 5:27; Acts 7:56; etc.)
- d. **be delivered = paradidōmi** (παραδίδωμι) = "to hand over to authority, to betray"
- e. **the chief priests and scribes** = 70-person religious council called the Sanhedrin (cf. Matt. 16:21)
- f. **they will condemn Him to death** = a trial that signals Israel's final rejection of their King until the Tribulation (cf. Zech. 12:10; John 19:37)
- g. **will hand Him over to the Gentiles to mock and scourge and crucify Him**
 - i. Pontius Pilate served as the Roman governor of Judea under Emperor Tiberius from 26 to 36 A.D. but his

benefactor was executed for treason in A.D. 31 (cf. John 19:12; Matt. 27:22-30)

- ii. A Roman Flagrum was a short whip made of three or more leather straps that were knotted with a weight at the end and embedded with metal, nails, and bone shards (cf. Ps. 22:16-18; Isa. 53:3-6ff; cf. Lev. 26; Deut. 27-28; Gal. 3:13; Col. 2:14)
- h. **on the third day He will be raised up.**" (cf. Jonah 1:17; Matt. 12:38-40; 16:21; 17:23; John 10:17-18; Rom. 8:11; & 1 Cor. 15:1-8; cf. 2 Cor. 1:5; Phil. 3:10; Heb. 2:10; 1 Peter 1:11; 4:13)
