

What Does the Bible Say About Demons?

I. Do Demons Exist?

- a. _____ (Judges 9:23; 1 Kings 22:20–23; Matt. 6:33; 10:1; 12:43, 45; 17:18; Mark 1:26-27; 3:11 5:1-20, 8, 13; Luke 4:36; 6:18; 11:26; Acts 5:16; 8:7; 1 Peter 5:8; Jude 1:6; Rev. 12:9)

II. What Are Demons?

- a. _____ (cf. Job 38:6-7; 1:6-7; Matt. 4:1, 5; John 12:31; Eph. 2:2; 2 Cor. 4:4; Rev. 12:10)
- b. Satan's rebellion and fall may actually be described several times in Scripture (cf. Isa. 14:12-15; cf. Gen. 3:1–15; Isa.14:12–17; Ezek. 28:11–19; Matt. 4:1–11; 25:41; Luke 10:18; 2 Cor. 4:3–4; Rev. 12:1–14; 20:10)
- c. The devil did not fall alone, he may have taken a third of the heavenly angels with him (cf. Rev. 12:3-4)

III. Are There Different Kinds of Demons?

- a. _____
- b. It does appear that there are different kinds, categories, or ranks of God's heavenly angels:
 - i. _____ (cf. Isa. 6:1-2ff)
 - ii. _____ (Ex. 25:18-20; cf. Gen. 3:24; Ex. 37:7-9; 1 Sam. 4:4; 2 Sam. 22:11; Ezek. 10)
 - iii. _____ (cf. Dan. 8:16; 9:21; Luke 1:19, 26; & Jude 1:9; " cf. Dan. 10:13, 21; 12:1; Rev. 12:7)

- c. There "may" also be some lists of different classifications or ranks of demons (Eph. 6:12; cf. Romans 8:37–39; Colossians 1:16; 2:15; Ephesians 3:10–11; Titus 3:1)
- d. Some try to name or label demons: Jezebel Spirits, Delilah's, or Territorial Spirits; and build supposed ministries, demonologies, and methodologies around these categories; and still others contend that demons have given them this special "knowledge" and additional insight into the spiritual realm.
 - i. I warn you to not ADD to God's Word and definitely NOT to listen to evil spirits and demons because they are by their very nature liars (cf. John 8:44)

IV. Can Demons Possess People?

- a. _____ (cf. cf. Matt. 8:16, 29; 9:32-33; 12:22; 17:14-18; Mark 5:1-20; 7:26-30; Luke 4:33-36; 8:27-33; 11:20; 22:3; Acts 16:16-18)
- b. They can cause:
 - i. Physical ailments
 - ii. Super strength (Luke 8:29ff; cf. Matt. 8:28-34; Mark 5:1-17)
 - iii. Force wicked activity (cf. Gen. 6:4ff; 1 Peter 3:18-20; Jude 1:6)
 - iv. Perform pseudo-miracles (cf. Acts 16:16ff; 2 Thess. 2:8-9; 2 Cor. 11:14; 1 John 1:4; 4:1ff)

- c. But they are NOT gods and Jesus has defeated them!

V. Can Demons Possess Christians?

- a. _____ (cf. 1 John 4:4; 1 Cor. 3:16; 6:19; Rom. 8:9-11)
- b. But **Demon Oppression** is possible! (cf. 1 Peter 5:8-9; cf. Matt. 4; 16:23; Eph. 6:11)
 - i. This is when an evil spirit attacks a Believer or tries to influence and encourage them to sin and to disobey God
- c. But there is no such thing as a third category called **"Demonization"**
