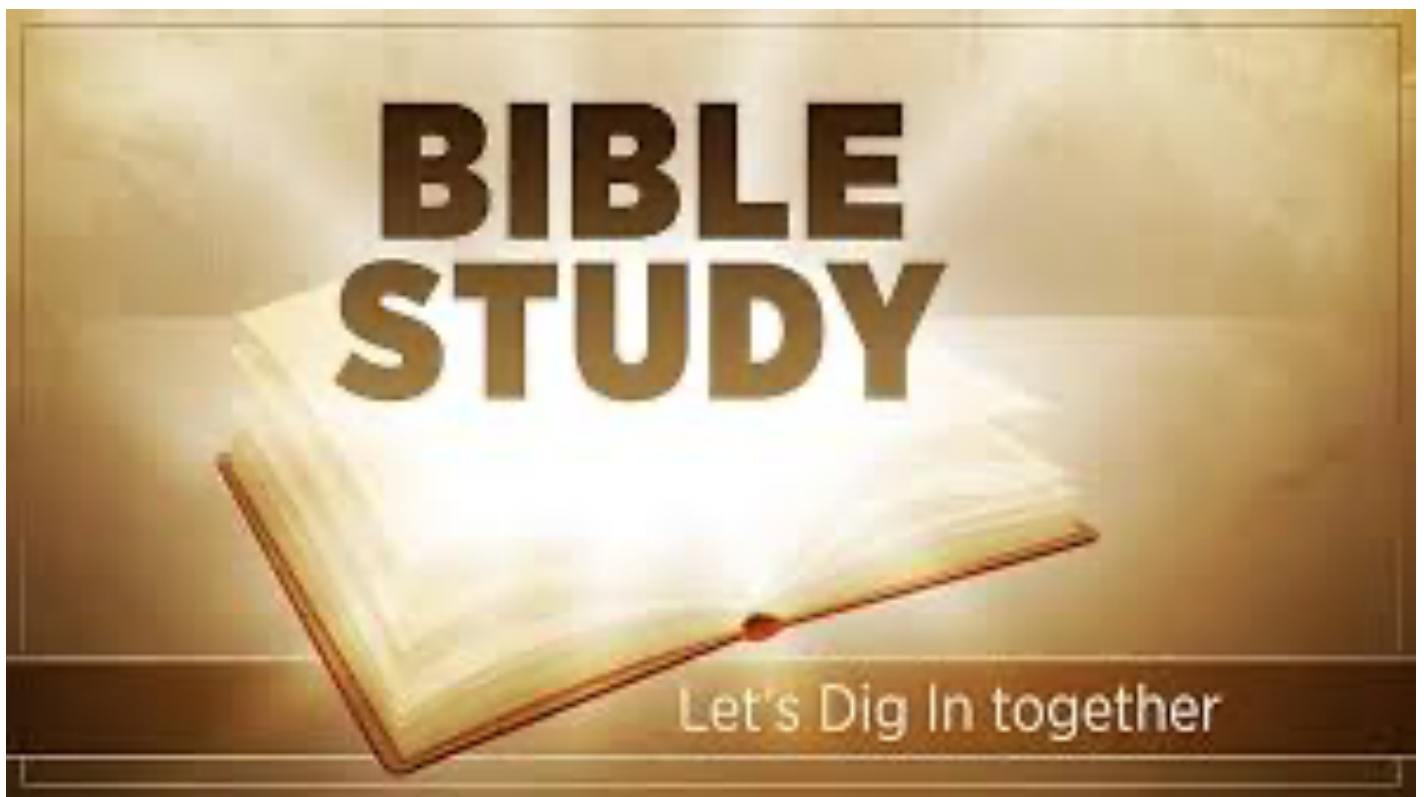

1. Nicodemus was a smart, strong, kind, curious person. Jesus told him that something was _____ if he wished to be in _____. He was previously born of flesh. Now he must be "born of the Spirit" (*John 3*).
2. Thomas was zealous, but cautious and skeptical. Jesus told him that he must abandon his _____ and put all ALL _____ in Christ as Savior. This means an end of self-effort and a beginning (birth) of trusting God. There is only one "way" to God, which is Jesus Christ (*John 14*).
3. Jesus described the human birth process as both pain and joy; the joy so strong that the pain is forgotten. Then he said, "Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be full" (*Jn. 16:24*).
