Revelation 2:1-7

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January 31-February 1, 2026

1. How does it comfort you to know that Christ is walking among us? How is it convicting?
2. What does it mean to you that God commended the church in Ephesus for their serving and sacrifice? Does this affect the way you serve and sacrifice? Why or why not?
3. How would you rate your steadfastness? Why? Are there some areas you would say you are strong in, and other areas in which you are weak? If so, give examples of each.
4. What are some things to look for in trying to figure out if someone is teaching false doctrine?
5. What did Jesus mean when He said, “you have abandoned the love you had at first?”
6. What were you like when you first became a Christ follower? What are some spiritual disciplines you practiced then that you don’t now? What’s one specific change you can make?
7. How have you seen activity and busyness replace affection?
8. What area do you serve in? Why do you serve? Do you serve out of obligation, or because you love the Lord and want to serve Him?
9. Jesus says they did not *lose* their first love — they left it. Why is that distinction important?
10. What would those who know you best say is your priority? Why? Does there need to be some adjustment here? If so, what are some things you can do to make Christ your top priority?
11. What has Christ done for you? Is there anything you need to repent of?
12. What would happen to our community if God were to “remove your lampstand from its place?”
13. Take time to pray for revival for yourself first, then for your family, and then for our church.
