3. Why is it important to realize that God pursued us instead of us pursuing Him?
4. What does the word behold mean? What does it mean to behold the Lamb of God? What surprises you? What are you hoping for? What expectations do you have? How certain are you?
5. What surprised Mary, Joseph, and the shepherds? What were they hoping for? What expectations did they have? How certain were they about what they heard?
6. What are you becoming? What does that tell you that you are beholding?
7. How do you feel about God providing the proper sacrifice for Himself?
8. Why couldn't God just overlook our sin? Why did it have to be completely removed?
9. Why is it important that Jesus died for everyone? Not just the Jews?
10. Why is Jesus' sacrifice the final one? Why did this end the sacrificing of lambs?
11. How are you following Jesus? Is there an area in your life that you are not following Him in? If so, what are you going to do about it?
