

# The Perfect Christ Note Answers

John 1:29-34

**Main Point:** Behold and believe in the Lamb of God so He will lift away your sin.

## The Urgent Look

1. "The next day" refers to the day after the religious leaders \_\_\_\_\_ John.
2. It was also the day after Jesus returned from His 40-day \_\_\_\_\_ in the wilderness.
3. The phrase "the fullness of time" means something is complete and \_\_\_\_\_ developed, like ripe fruit ready to be picked.
4. The stage was perfectly set for the \_\_\_\_\_ to be sent (Luke 2:6).
5. Jesus was "coming toward him." John didn't go looking for Jesus but rather, Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ him out.
6. Before we ever move toward Christ, He has already moved \_\_\_\_\_ us.
7. "Behold" means "to \_\_\_\_\_ through sight, to peer, to spy out, to gaze intently upon, to observe fully."
8. It expresses strong feelings of surprise, hope, \_\_\_\_\_ and certainty.
9. The word "behold" is designed to grab \_\_\_\_\_ and to signal that what follows is important, surprising, and worthy of reflection.
10. Everyone who was approached by an angel was called to perceive, believe, and \_\_\_\_\_ this good news.

## The Unique Lamb

1. We are to behold the lamb.
2. Jesus is the supreme and \_\_\_\_\_ lamb provided by God.
3. "Of God" emphasized the \_\_\_\_\_ of God.
4. This lamb belongs to God and is given by God as a \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifice.
5. It's not about what we offer to God, but about the gift of God \_\_\_\_\_ to us (Romans 8:32).
6. In the book of Revelation, the \_\_\_\_\_ is the most frequent title for Jesus.

## The Unmatched Liberation (John 1:29)

1. The phrase "takes away" means "to take up, to take away and \_\_\_\_\_ on oneself.
2. He did not merely overlook human transgression, but actively "lifted" the weight of our despicable depravity and \_\_\_\_\_ it upon Himself.
3. He came as the Lamb of God to completely \_\_\_\_\_ them.
4. Through the blood of Jesus, our sins have been paid, and we can now experience forgiveness and eternal \_\_\_\_\_ (Hebrews 9:12, 10:10)
5. Jesus did not die as just another sacrifice, but as the final, \_\_\_\_\_ one, once for all.
6. He is with you through His birth. Make sure He is in you through the new birth. And then allow Him to \_\_\_\_\_ through you in your life.

7. When John the Baptist's disciples looked up and saw the Lamb of God, they left John to \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus.
8. We must put our \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus and follow Him.
9. Look to the Lamb who is Lord and be \_\_\_\_\_ from your sins right now.
