2. What did Paul do here to help Philemon and Onesimus out?
3. Is there someone you need to make amends to for the sake of Christ? What step can you take this week?
4. Is there someone you need to forgive that has hurt you? What can you do that will help you to forgive them?
5. Have you ever let go of anything that felt like tearing your heart out? What happened? How did you grow from that experience?
6. Is there something in your life now that you don't want to let go of? Why? Is this something that you need to be willing to let go?
7. What is something in your life that you are trying to control that you need to let God take control and trust Him with it? What makes this a difficult decision?
8. What are some things God wants us to do willingly? Why doesn't He force us to do it?
9. What are some things you do because you feel obligated or because it is expected of you, or that you have been forced to do?
10. What difference does the attitude you do something with make in the performance of the task? Why is attitude important?
11. How have you been blessed by giving to God?
12. How has someone pointed out that your circumstances are a way that God is working in your life?

13. How did God use Onesimus running away to work in Philemon's life?
14. How is God working in your life right now? Do we always like what God is doing at the time? Why or why not? What makes it hard to trust God during these times?
