

# Finding Refuge Notes

## Psalm 16

**Main Point:** When we run to God for refuge, we will find confidence and contentment now and forevermore.

### Five Anchors

1. \_\_\_\_\_ from the Lord (Psalm 16:1-2)
  - The word “preserve” means, “to \_\_\_\_\_, to keep safe, to watch over.”
  - The word “refuge” refers to a place of \_\_\_\_\_ or shelter.
  - God is our shelter and our \_\_\_\_\_ (Psalm 16:2).
  - Three names of God is used here:
    - El = God. This name emphasizes His role as Creator.
    - Jehovah = LORD. He is the covenant-keeping God.
    - Adonai = Lord. This refers to Him as Master.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ from the Lord.
  - Savoring time with the \_\_\_\_\_ (Psalm 16:3).
    - The word “saints” is a synonym for \_\_\_\_\_ and refers to those who are set apart by God for His purposes.
    - They are called “excellent ones,” which means, “\_\_\_\_\_, majestic, royal, noble, and precious.”
    - The word “delight” has the idea of \_\_\_\_\_.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ from sin (Psalm 16:4).
    - David paints a vivid picture of how vices can lead to pain because ungodly behavior often ends in \_\_\_\_\_.
    - The word “run” means to “\_\_\_\_\_ after” unholy behavior.
    - In an effort to avoid legalism, I fear the evangelical church has become soft about calling people to be separated from sin.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ from the Lord.

    - If you know Jesus through the new birth, Romans 8:17 says you are “\_\_\_\_\_ of God and fellow heirs with Christ.”
4. \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord.
