1. What does it mean for us that Jesus remained steadfast and wasn't led astray by Satan lies? What did He use to fight temptation? What verses do you use to fight temptation? Which ones may be helpful to memorize to be able to use them when temptation comes?
2. How can we be alert to the devil's schemes? When do we need to be on guard the most? What are some of the schemes that Satan uses?
3. What lies did Satan use with Eve? Why would Eve listen to this serpent over God who she had a personal relationship with? Why do you think Eve fell for the lies?
4. What things do you desire that you need to be careful that you are not falling into one of Satan's lies?
5. What are some things that you do so that you don't feel like you are missing out? Would you do these things if you knew you weren't going to miss something? Why or why not?
6. What does disobedience bring shame? What do we do when we feel shame? Why?
7. If you were to introduce yourself as they do in Celebrate Recovery, what would you say?
8. How do we try to hide from ourselves? What does this look like?
9. Why are we more tempted to sin when we are alone? Bored? Why do we pull away from others while we are living in sin, especially those who would confront us about it?
10. How has God shown you mercy?
11. What is your redemption and restoration story?
12. How did Adam and Eve make things worse by not taking responsibility for their sin and blaming others? Who have you blamed for your sins or problems? Have you ever blamed God for something? If so, why?
13. Have you ever thought that by choosing to sin, you were communicating to God that that sin was more important to you than God? How does this make you feel about your sin and about God? Why does God still pursue us even when we reject Him?
14. How does our sin affect our relationships not only with God but also other people around us?
