1. What experience have you had that astonished and amazed you? Why was it astonishing and amazing to you?
2. What does it mean to be holy? How does our holiness compare to God's holiness?
3. What are some ways we try to keep God from reigning over us?
4. What does it mean for someone to reign? What happens if we don't like the way that person is reigning over us? How does this apply to God reigning over us?
5. Why should we "tremble" or "shake" before God?
6. Does God need cherubim to guard His holiness? Why or why not?
7. Read Psalm 96:3. What are some ways we can "declare His glory among the nations?"
8. What does "equity" mean? How do you define "justice." Does God's definition of justice differ from yours? Why or why not?
9. How does our desire for justice reflect the character of God? How does this relate to our being created in God's image?
10. Does it feel like justice is prevailing in the world today? Why or why not? What does it mean to you that God's justice will prevail? Why does God wait? Why doesn't He give us justice now? What would it mean for us if God's justice would occur for all of us now?
11. How can we exalt Him or lift Him up in our lives? Have you surrendered and submitted to Him completely?
12. Why do we still suffer consequences for our sins even though we have asked for and received forgiveness?
13. What are you petitioning God for this week?
14. How does holiness lead to happiness?
15. Will you take time this week to read the opening chapters of Ezekiel and Isaiah 6? If you do, what did you take away from this reading?
16. Take time to thank God for His forgiveness of specific sins in your life. Thank Him for the mercy He has shown to you. Take time to worship Him.
17. What areas in your life do you need to improve in your holiness? (Social media, gaming, work, marriage, thoughts, relationships, etc.)
