1. What strikes you about this passage of scripture?
2. Why do we need to ask God to be gracious to us?
3. Why do we want God to bless us?
4. What do we need to do to “make His face to shine upon us?”
5. What do you usually pray for in your prayers? Are your prayers more self-focused or others-focused? Why should our prayers be more focused on others instead of ourselves?
6. How are you making God’s glory and gospel known to all the peoples of the earth?
7. Would people describe you as God’s light shining through you? Why or why not? What can you do to improve this perception?
8. What feelings do you have when you hear that there are 7,000 people groups, which makes up over 3 billion people, or 42% of the world that have not been reached by the gospel? What is something that we can do to change this?
9. Whose priorities do you put first in your life? Yours or God’s? Why?
10. Why does obedience lead to blessing? What happens when you are disobedient to God?
11. Do you feel like your soul is satisfied with God? Why or why not? Is God really enough for you or do you want other things?
12. Are you looking for God to bless you just so you have more stuff, or do you want God’s blessing so that you can bless others? How do we know which type we are?
13. Read Haggai 1:9. Why would God blow away what “they brought home?” Do you ever feel like you can’t get ahead? Could it be because you are disobeying God in something and He is blowing away what you brought home?
14. In what ways have you gotten so busy with your own stuff that you didn’t have time to do God’s business?
15. Would you say that you live a me-centered life or a God-centered life? Why?
