2. What reaction did you have when you first met Jesus?
3. The young boy was willing to give all his lunch to Jesus. What are you giving to Jesus? What are you willing to give to Him? Why?
4. Read Matthew 21:15-16. Why did the religious leaders get upset with the children praising Jesus? How does it make you feel to hear children praising Jesus?
5. Read Matthew 11:25. Why are children able to understand things that the wise can't understand?
6. What do you think about the fact that 2 of the 3 people Jesus raised from the dead were children? What does that say to you?
7. Why is it important that Jesus demonstrate power over disease, death, and the devil? What does this mean for us?
8. Read Matthew 23:37. Why wasn't Jerusalem willing to allow the Lord to gather them together under His wings?
9. Why would it be better to have a millstone fastened around your neck and drown in the sea than to cause a child to sin?
10. How can children be an example of faith?
11. What kind of impact are we having on children when we bring them to church to hear God's word? Why is this important?
