1. Why do you choose to give to Edgewood? If you don't give, why not?
2. How are we partners with missionaries during good times and bad when we give to them? What do you think it does for the missionaries to receive your gift? What does it do for you to give to them?
3. When did you start giving to God's work on a regular basis? What blessings have you received from giving? How has God met your needs while you have given to His work?
4. When you haven't given to God, have you ever noticed that money was tighter or more needs arose? Explain?
5. Why is it important to have the right attitude about your giving? What attitude should we have? Should we give if we don't have the right attitude? Why or why not?
6. How does giving away our money release the hold money can have on us? If we are unwilling to give, what does that say about our heart and our priorities?
7. How have you seen God "multiply" your giving to do more than you ever thought possible? What kind of things does He do?
8. What are some of the warnings the Bible gives us about our wealth or treasures?
9. How does our giving become an act of worshiping God? What does our giving communicate to God, others around us, and to ourselves?
10. What do you think the Philippians would have missed out on if they hadn't obeyed God and sent their gifts to Paul? What do you miss out on, by not obeying God when He leads you to give?
11. If God promises to meet all our needs, why are there still people who starve and go without? Does this mean that God doesn't keep His promises? Why or why not?
12. What joy do you get from giving?
13. Tell a story, if you know one, of how your support of a missionary or someone else, allowed them to share the gospel with someone that otherwise would not have heard the gospel?
14. Do you give out of duty or delight? How do you know which one you are doing?
