1. What do you view as your role in the church when it comes to kids and students? Why? How can you have an impact on their lives?
2. Why is it primarily the parents' role to educate their children about God instead of it being primarily the church's role?
3. How much influence do you think a Sunday School teacher, Kid's church teacher, Awana leader, Youth Group leader really has on a child's life when we may spend 1 to 2 hours with them a week if that?
4. How much more influence does a schoolteacher have on children?
5. How much influence does a parent have? A grandparent?
6. Why did Asaph take the time to put to music this story of the Israelites wondering around the desert? What did he want them to learn or remember about God?
7. Have you kept a record of the things God has done in your life? Have you told your kids or others how God has answered your prayers? Why is it important to write these things down? Why is it important to share them with your kids or with others? Why is it important to go back and look at all God has done?
8. Why is it important for people to learn about God? What should a knowledge about God lead us to do?
9. Is it enough just to know about God? Why or why not? What else is there?
10. If your parents were Christians, did they ever share with you stories about God working in their life? If so, would you share one of those stories with us?
11. What story would you want the next generation to know about how God worked in your life?
12. How does one love God with all their heart, all your soul, and with all your might? Are you doing this in your life? Is there an area you are keeping from the Lord? How can you give this over to God? Are you faking it or is it real? Explain your answer?
13. Why do we have to repeatedly teach our kids or others about God?
14. What is a simple way in a small moment that you can teach your kids about God? If you don't have kids, that you can share about God in a brief interaction with a kid or student?
15. How can Edgewood become better at coming alongside parents and grandparents in discipling our kids and students? How can you be a part of making Edgewood better at this?
