6. Why is each of these areas important? What happens if we don't love God with one of these areas?
7. Why does our love of God extend to the people around us?
8. What issue do you have with one of your neighbors? What can you do to show limitless and unconditional love for this neighbor?
9. How does our not loving our neighbors show that we really don't love God?
10. How would your neighborhood feel if you were to move out of the area? Why?
11. What can you pray about regarding reaching out to your neighbors?
12. When you talk to your neighbors, what do you think their needs are? What are some of the struggles they are facing so that you can pray for them?
13. Is there something you can do to get to know your neighbors better?
14. What is it about eating with someone that makes people feel more comfortable and helps us open up with one another?
15. Is there something you can do to serve your neighbor?
16. How does all of this allow us to have a gospel conversation with them?
17. Why is obedience better than sacrifice?
18. Would God consider you far from the kingdom of God, close to the kingdom, or in the kingdom? Why?
