1. What message does God want us to apply to our lives today from what was written to the church at Pergamum?
2. How can we live among unbelievers and not compromise our beliefs and have an impact for the kingdom of God?
3. What are some challenges and temptations that we face by living in a place like Pergamum? How can we deal with these challenges and temptations?
4. What was God communicating to the church by identifying Himself as “Him who has the sharp two-edged sword?”
5. Where do you think is Satan’s headquarters right now? Why?
6. Would Jesus call you steadfast in your faith? Why or why not? What have you sacrificed for your faith?
7. Could we be holding on to incorrect beliefs in the church today? Why or why not? What could some of those be?
8. How do you view sin? Does the way you live prove that you view sin this way? Why or why not? How should one live if they view sin as serious? How does one live if they don’t take sin seriously? Why does this matter to us?
9. Do you think there is too much “Rock Island (the world) in Edgewood?” Why or why not? Is there too much of the world in your life? Why or why not?
10. What is Jesus calling you to change in your life? In Edgewood?
11. What does God mean when He says if they don’t repent “I will come to you soon and war against them with the sword of my mouth?”
12. Are there things you need to repent of before it is too late?
13. What do you think of the hidden manna that will be given to the conquerors?
14. How does God fulfill the promise of the “white stone” to us in each of the cultural connections (citizenship, not guilty, victory, access, reward for courage, friendship)?
15. How do you feel about having a new name to go with your new body in Heaven? Have you given much thought to this before? Why or why not?
