1. What is this passage of Scripture warning you against in your life?
2. Are there ways that your job or hobbies are influencing your morality or causing you to compromise in areas? If so, how?
3. Have you minimized Jesus in your life? Is He in first place in your life? How can you tell what is in first place in your life?
4. Do you ask the question “What can Jesus do for me?” In what ways do we ask this question?
5. What does it mean for someone to be lord over another person? How do we move from “What can Jesus do for me?” to “Am I living in light of His Lordship? Is Jesus truly Lord of your life?”
6. Are you serving a fabricated Jesus, one that makes you feel good or one that makes you feel bad? Do you just try to fit Him in whenever and however He best suits you? How do you know that you are serving the real Jesus? How have you fought with God or been angry or disappointed with Him? Why is this important?
7. What would God commend you for? Would He commend your works, love, faith, service, endurance? How would you say you are doing in each of these areas?
8. What would God say that He has against you? Are there things you are tolerating in your life or in your home that you shouldn't be? If so, how can you go about ridding your life or home of these things?
9. Is there a “Jezebel” in your life that you need to be aware of that is trying to lead you astray?
10. How can fearing God prevent you from sinning? Will you give an example of this?
11. Why are we attracted to things that are deep, hidden, or secretive?
12. Do we have to be careful with Christian literature? What do we need to look out for when we are reading Christian books? How do we discern if a book is really a Christ-centered and honoring book?
13. What does it mean that “the one who conquers and keeps my works until the end to him I will give authority over the nations...?”
14. How does even the smallest amount of light affect you in a very dark place? How does holding on to the hope of Christ coming help us to get through the darkness of this world today?
