1. What does it mean that God had nothing to commend the church at Sardis? How does a church get to this point?
2. How would it make you feel for God to tell you that you are spiritually dead when you thought you were spiritually alive? How can we know if we are alive or dead?
3. Is everything that we do for the Lord really unto the Lord? Why or why not? If not, what makes the difference?
4. What kind of reputation do you have around work, around home, with your friends? Are you the same when no one is watching? Why or why not?
5. How do you spiritually wake up a church? A family? An individual? What steps can you take to move from being complacent to spiritually on fire?
6. What do we have to keep? Why do we have to keep a close eye on it?
7. Is there anything you need to repent of? Are there any areas in your life where you have been complacent? Are you producing the fruit of the spirit?
8. Do you try to stay away from sin? If so, how? If not, what draws you to it?
9. How does knowing that your name will never be blotted out of the book of life affect you?
10. Why is it important that Jesus will confess your name to His Father?
