

Avoid Being Lukewarm Discussion Questions

Revelation 3:14-22

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1. What does it mean to be a lukewarm Christian? Would you consider yourself to be lukewarm? Why or why not?
2. Why did Jesus use the title, "the words Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of God's creation" with the church at Laodicea? What is the connection between the church's complacency and self-sufficiency that God would use this title with them?
3. Why would God prefer them to be cold or hot instead of lukewarm? What makes it difficult to reach and change those who are lukewarm?
4. Do you identify with the Laodiceans in that you feel you have everything you need and are successful? What did Christ say to them in Revelation 3:17? Would Christ say the same type of things to us today? Why or why not?
5. When Jesus is talking about buying gold in Revelation 3:18 is He referring to gold that we can use on earth or Heavenly riches? How do we get Heavenly riches that have been refined by fire?
6. Why do we need spiritual covering?
7. How do we need to see the people we meet and the circumstances we go through? How does looking at them through a spiritual perspective help us to deal with people and difficult circumstances?
8. How does God discipline us? Why does He discipline us?
9. In what areas of your life have you become lukewarm in? How can you warm up the temperature and become hot in these areas?
10. What does it mean for Jesus to be on the outside of the door instead of inside? Is there a door in your life that you need to open up to the Savior and let Him in?
11. If Jesus is not Lord of all areas of your life, is He really Lord of your life? Why or why not?
12. What does it mean to have fellowship with the Lord?
13. What do we need to conquer in order to sit on the throne with Christ?
14. What is God saying to you and to Edgewood through the messages delivered to the seven churches? What can we improve so we are found faithful when Christ returns?
