1. Read Revelation 6:1-2 and 19:11-12. What are the similarities and differences between the riders of these white horses? Is this the same person or two different people? Why?
2. Why is it important that the devil is under the control of Christ?
3. Why does all the destruction that takes place lead to famine?
4. How do you feel about all of your wages for one day going to pay for your food for that day? What kind of changes would this cause?
5. What do you think will happen to society to lose $\frac{1}{4}$ of its population? What about businesses, schools, and such?
6. Why would God allow people to be martyred for their belief in Him? What impact could this have on other people who witness it or hear about it?
7. How do we fit in God's plan?
8. What would it take for an earthquake to shake the sun, moon, and stars? What kind of impact would this have on the earth?
9. What does it mean that the sky vanished and every mountain and island being moved? How will this affect life on earth?
10. Why would everyone hide in caves and in the rocks in the mountains?
11. Who would be able to stand before a holy God? Why or why not?
