5. How did Rehoboam's decision affect the entire nation?

7. Read Ecclesiastes 2:20-23. What were the feelings King Solomon was having about his work? What part of your work makes you feel the same things as Solomon? Why?
8. How does focusing on God with our work make a difference in the way we feel about our work and in the way we perform our work?
9. What pleasure does God give you from your work as you please Him?
10. How does God bring despair from work when people are not pleasing Him?
11. What do you imagine work would be like if it wasn't affected by sin (no weeds, no weariness, etc.)
