1. Would you say that you live wisely or foolishly? Why?
2. How can one decision ruin your reputation?
3. Is there something you are playing around with that could result in ruining your reputation? What are some things you can do to put up barriers, so you don't ruin your reputation with unwise decisions and actions?
4. How does our heart affect the things we do or don't do?
5. What kind of actions or attitudes reveal that a person is following the foolish path?
6. What are some things we can do that will help us to remain calm when things start getting heated?
7. Would you briefly share an example of instance where someone was seeking revenge or trying to get back at someone that came back on them?
8. What can make us spiritually dull? What are some ways to stay or become spiritually sharp?
9. What makes a person procrastinate? What are the dangers of procrastinating?
10. What are some things we procrastinate doing spiritually? What harm can come from doing that?
11. Will you give an example of a time you said something about someone else that you later regretted? What problems did it cause? Were you able to repair the relationship? If so, what did it take?
12. Why is it hard to watch what we say?
13. Does the way of the fool look attractive or fun at times? Why or why not?
14. Why is it foolish to overindulge ourselves? How do we know when we are indulging ourselves too much?
15. Do you find yourself talking about others often? Would you want them to know what you are saying? Why or why not? What wisdom is Ecclesiastes 10:20 and Luke 12:2-3 giving us?
