6. How are you showing love to those around you daily?
7. Who do you pray for on a regular basis? Why do we pray for these people regularly?

9. With the observations Pastor Brian made about Paul's prayers, that he didn't pray for protect, material possessions, or their circumstances to change, but for God to reveal what they already had, how does this make you think about your prayer life?
