Discussion Questions

Ephesians 2:1-10

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1. Describe a time you became distracted and ended up forgetting important details. In what ways are you prone to forget essential spiritual truths? How can you combat this?
2. What would you say to someone who believes that people are inherently good in their nature? What verses would you point them to?
3. Share an example from our culture about how the world, the devil, and the flesh are at work today. Now, share an example of a time you succumbed to one of these insidious forces in your own life.
4. Why do you think the doctrine of the wrath of God is so repugnant to many people? Why do some churches refuse to teach about it? Read John 3:36. Do you see unbelievers under the wrath of God today? How would our efforts at evangelism change if we really believed this?
5. Share your “But God” conversion story in less than 50 words.
6. There are 45 “But God” verses in the Bible. Look up some of these passages and discuss the main idea of each one (Acts 7:9-10; Romans 5:8; Genesis 8:1; Romans 6:23; 1 Corinthians 3:6; Psalm 73:267; Matthew 19:26; Jonah 2:6).
7. Share a “But God” testimony of how God worked in a hopeless situation in your life.
8. Who comes to your mind right now as a “trophy of God’s grace?” What stands out about them? Send them a text right now to encourage them.
9. Has there been a time you were certain that God had prepared a work for you to do? What did you have to surrender in order to be obedient? What is God calling you to right now? Tell someone and ask them to hold you accountable.
10. Who will you share the gospel of grace with this week?
