1. How do you see the signs of God at work at Edgewood?
2. What does it mean to imitate something? What are some character qualities of God that we need to imitate? Why do we need to imitate God?
3. How did Christ show love to those He was around on earth? In what ways can we show His love to others?
4. Jesus' love was sacrificial. How are you sacrificing to show God's love to others?
5. Why is it important for us to live pure lives? Why do we need to leave ungodly things behind?
6. Why do you think Paul makes a point to focus on sexual sins and our speech?
7. Why are these things "out of place" for believers?
8. Why is it dangerous to joke about sin?
9. How does being thankful to God for what you have and what He has done going to stop you from sinning?
10. Do we do these sins because we are angry at God or feel entitled to something and wrongly think somehow, we are getting even with Him? Why or why not? If not, why do we do these sins?
