1. What did you learn from the myths of Christmas? Was there one that you pushed back on? Why?
2. What does it mean that Jesus is the Word of God?
3. Read John 8:58 and 2 Timothy 1:9. Do you find it hard to think of Jesus as always existing even though He was born on earth in Bethlehem? Why or why not?
4. How does Jesus as “Logos” bring meaning, wisdom, and rationality to us?
5. The sermon said that “Jesus revealed what goes on in the mind of God” and that He is “the bridge between God and us.” How do these statements impact you?
6. What is the difference between being “with” God and being “towards God” or “face to face?”
7. Read John 1:1 and John 10:30. How does John and Jesus Himself make it clear that Jesus is God?’
8. Read Revelation 1:8. What does it mean that Jesus is the Alpha and the Omega? Why is this important to us?
9. Read John 1:3 and Colossians 1:16-17. Why is it important for us to understand that Jesus was present at creation and that He made everything?
10. Why is it important to understand that Jesus was not created and that He has always existed? What does this mean for us?
11. Why is doctrine and knowing what we believe so important?
12. Why is it important for Jesus to come down to earth as a man?
13. Why did He willingly die on the cross? What impact does that have on you?
14. What are you willing to do to show how much you love Him?
