1. How do you honor your father? What is one thing that your father taught you?
2. How does our decision to follow Christ and sharing our faith with others impact generations to come? Can you give an example of this?
3. What kind of covenants or binding commitments have you made? Why did you make them? How are you doing at keeping them?
4. How has God been faithful to you and your family? How has God been faithful to our church?
5. Is there a place that reminds you of decisions you have made or that is important to you? What is that place and why is it important to you?
6. Is there a “god” or “idol” you need to “put away” from your life? What is interfering with you spending time in God’s Word, coming to church, and fellowshiping with God’s people?
7. How do you revere God? What helps you to see Him as heavy and holy?
8. How and why does seeing God as heavy and holy lead us to serving Him? In what ways do you serve the Lord? Would you say you are serving with sincerity or just out of duty or obligation?
9. Are you obeying God? Why or why not? If you are obeying Him, are you doing so with a willing and happy heart? What difference does it make if you are complaining while obeying?
10. Do you feel like worshipping God or going to church is a chore? Why or why not? If you do, what can you do to change the way you feel about it?
11. Who have you chosen to serve? Why? If you have chosen to follow the Lord, how has it affected your control on your own life? Is this a good thing or a bad thing? Why? If you have decided to serve yourself or Satan, how has your life been? Are you happy being in control of your life? Are you really in control? Why or why not?
12. How are you leading your household in following the Lord? How are you being intentional about this? What priorities have you set and why?
13. How is Christ-liked manhood different from the world’s view of manhood?
14. What new habits do you need to put in place to keep your commitment to God?
15. Write out a personal mission statement or a family purpose statement for serving the Lord.
16. What visual reminders do you and your family have to remind you of your commitment to serve the Lord? If you don’t have any, what could you get or create to have one?
