1. What's a memory you have of celebrating July 4th growing up?
2. Looking back at the list of ten ways God has shed His grace on America, which one are you most personally grateful for, and why?
3. Read 2 Chronicles 7:14 out loud. In what ways can this passage shape how we pray for ourselves, our nation, church, or community?
4. What does it look like practically to "humble yourself before the Lord" this week, rather than waiting for circumstances to humble you?
5. What's one honest obstacle that keeps your prayer life from being more disciplined?
6. What is the difference between seeking God's hand (what He gives) and seeking His face (who He is)?
7. Why do you think repentance is placed last in this sequence, after humility, prayer, and seeking God's face?
8. Of the four conditions (humble, pray, seek, turn), which one do you sense God is asking you to focus on this week?
9. How does knowing God hears bring you comfort?
10. In what ways have you experienced God's forgiveness?
11. Chuck Colson wrote that we shouldn't "deify our country" or "wrap the flag around the cross," yet we are still called to love and serve our specific communities. How do we balance being faithful, loving citizens of an earthly nation while keeping our ultimate allegiance to the Kingdom of God?
12. Spend time praying for revival in your life and in our church.
